

Recommendations:

We feel installing traffic signals at the following intersections as soon as possible will allow the traffic to flow more uniformly along Stonehaven to eliminate the stopping and starting at all the stop signs located at all these intersections (excluding the one yet to be constructed at Roch Carrier school.

Traffic Signals need to be installed at the following intersections:

- Corner of Stonehaven and Bridlewood Drive
- Corner of Stonehaven and Bridgestone/Steeplechase
- Corner of Stonehaven and Stonemeadow
- Stonehaven and Stonemeadow (new) close to Roch Carrier School

In addition, we recommend right turns from Grassy Plains to Stonehaven on a red light be eliminated from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. which will allow residents to more easily turn left onto Stonehaven from Sawyer Meadows. Also, we recommend the completion of Crownridge which would assist in moving some of the traffic off Stonehaven from the south, however, as this requires the purchase of land by the City, this may not happen in the near future.

We recognize and have been told many times there is no funding for traffic lights, despite this, we have provided our recommendations, in an effort to move traffic along Stonehaven at a more reasonable pace. We also appreciate that Stonehaven to the east was always only designed as a "temporary" road/intersection. Unfortunately, due to circumstances, it has now become a main arterial road for Bridlewood residents. Our attempt in providing our recommendations is to be proactive in providing a solution to residents' concerns regarding traffic on Stonehaven. We fully appreciate Urbandale is going to continue with its development and we are foolish to think we can stop them. However, the City and Urbandale have the ability to partner to calm the concerns regarding Stonehaven traffic. We, do have a sense, this will be a step toward a solution.
