Meeting began at 2:00 p.m.

Erin Coffin advised Allan Hubley regarding the following:

- Transition of the BCA Executive;
- Status of the rinks,
- BCA Banking situation,
- Social Committee plan to increase event frequency and offer events for all ages,
- Core Constitution Committee work,
- Hope to increase attendance at monthly meetings and provide info sessions,

With respect to the Core Constitution Committee work Michelle Wright advised Pinehill, Bridlewood Trails, and Trailwest wish to stay independent.

RINKS


Erin Coffin advised Allan Hubley that the Sawyer Rink coordinators wished to have lights and boards in place. Allan Hubley reported this had been looked into previously and the City of Ottawa indicated this would be too costly. Moreover, he noted the City of Ottawa had denied putting boards in place as it was designed as a parking lot and there would be no one to move the items when the snow plow needed access. Michelle Wright advised she would look into a mesh substitute. Allan Hubley advised 4 parks and pathways per year are scheduled for conversion to LED lighting. However, he noted the process had started in Katimavik and would move southward.

BLUEGRASS PARK

Allan Hubley advised the City of Ottawa is putting together a proposal for the revitalization of Bluegrass Park. The initial intention was for the BCA, Allan Hubley's office, and the City of Ottawa to each provide 1/3 of the required funds. Once the proposal is finalized Michelle Wright will forward it to the BCA. Allan Hubley notes this project has not been locked in and the BCA can choose to use funds elsewhere if so desired.

EVA JAMES UPGRADE

Allan Hubley advised he only received money in the budget this year to hire a consultant to address a proposed expansion at Eva James Memorial C.C. Michelle Wright advised there is



hopes to expand the playground, install a secondary swing set, in addition to expanding the building itself. Allan Hubley noted Marc Favreau would sit on the committee for this expansion. Erin Coffin advised there would need to be a BCA representative as Marc Favreau has expressed, he does not want to be involved with the BCA at present.

MISC.

Michelle Wright advised the BCA can contact her with respect to community questions that would be better directed to the city, as well as safety issues. Erin Coffin indicated that the BCA would be happy to share any initiatives the city or councillor was offering through the BCA communication channels.
