KANATA SOUTH UPDATE: Councillor Hubley reportedly the following:

- Budget consultation is scheduled for October 28 from 7 - 8 pm - budget will not be tabled until a November.

- Garbage cans will be doubled up at the entrances of 5 local parks with cans removed inside parks.
- Michael Cowpland extension ongoing with second consultation this week.
- Kanata South Link is almost completed and Phase 2 is underway.
- A number of streets have been added to the list for restricted winter parking.
- Ward review is ongoing.
- Hydro is completing its clean up along corridor as well as seeding, etc.
- Apparently rat population is growing due to Provincial cuts in the use of pesticides 7 years ago. The City will respond to areas with complaints.
- Budget 2021 - It's anticipated 2021 will be a more normal year with general expenses similar to the last two years

TREASURER'S REPORT: Trevor Mulligan, Treasurer presented the 2020-2021 budget which can be viewed on the BCA website.

Trevor Mulligan moved and Danny Gress seconded a motion to approve the 2020-2021 Budget as presented. Carried.
