### Hydro One will apply pollinator seeds in the hydro corridor

In 2018, Hydro One removed trees and other vegetation in the hydro corridor to ensure safe distances exist between vegetation and power lines. This important work ensures hydro corridors are safe for public use, that lights remain on, and that our crews have safe access in emergencies.

**Hydro One will be seeding the section of the corridor highlighted in blue on the map below with a pollinator mix. Work is anticipated to start in early October.**

#### What does this work look like?

Hydro One crews will prepare the existing soil, add new topsoil and put down a pollinator mix. The pollinator mix will provide a habitat for bees, butterflies and wildlife. Please note that pollinator habitats take two years to reach full maturity.

We do appreciate your patience as the pollinator species take root.

#### How will the work be completed?

To complete this work, our crews will use mechanical equipment such as mini grinders, and other support vehicles. Our crews will do their best to minimize any inconvenience for residents located on the corridor.
